
## What were their challenges?

Six and 12 months after joining the program, students answered an open-ended question about how they're using their personal computer and Internet access. Here's what came up most often:











## How has their life changed?

Six months after joining the program, students answered an open-ended question about how their life has changed after receiving a computer and Internet access. Here's what came up most often:




# How has their life changed over time?
