We believe in a world where talent is not limited by geography or circumstance. Thank you for making it possible to create opportunities where they are needed most!

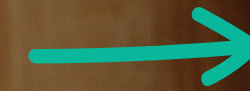
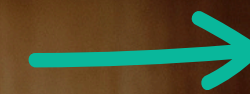
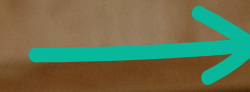

Our Impact in Numbers

This year

- **477** students brought online
- **538** new donors joined
- **2** new locations added



In total

- **3050** students supported
- **5671** donors
- **14** educational partners across **8** countries



The Problem

1.1 billion youth (aged 15-24) lack internet access. **67%** of whom are girls. Importantly, only **17%** of the world lives in an area without Internet coverage, making lack of affordability the main barrier to access.

The Solution

We find dedicated students in refugee camps, conflict affected and underserved areas, equip them with internet, laptops, skills training and help them find jobs and uplift their communities.



How we work

Educational Partners

We partner with two types of educational orgs: those, like **MIT Emerging Talent & Harvard Humanitarian Initiative**, that offer online educational programs for underserved and conflict affected students; and others, like **the University of Geneva**, that provide in-person training in refugee camps.

Student Selection & Connectivity

With our partners, we identify the most dedicated students entering or graduating from skills-development programs and support them with laptops and home internet access.

Lifelong Mentorship

Students join our online community for mentorship and support, where we host training and webinars and share education and job opportunities.



Sustainable Tech

We work with providers who refurbish high-quality second-hand laptops, reducing e-waste. This allows us to provide students with high-spec devices needed for technical subjects at an affordable cost.

Transparency

Donors receive monthly transparency reports with costs and achievement stories. We publish footage and stories from the field and advocate for connectivity.

Impact

We measure our impact with longitudinal qualitative studies.

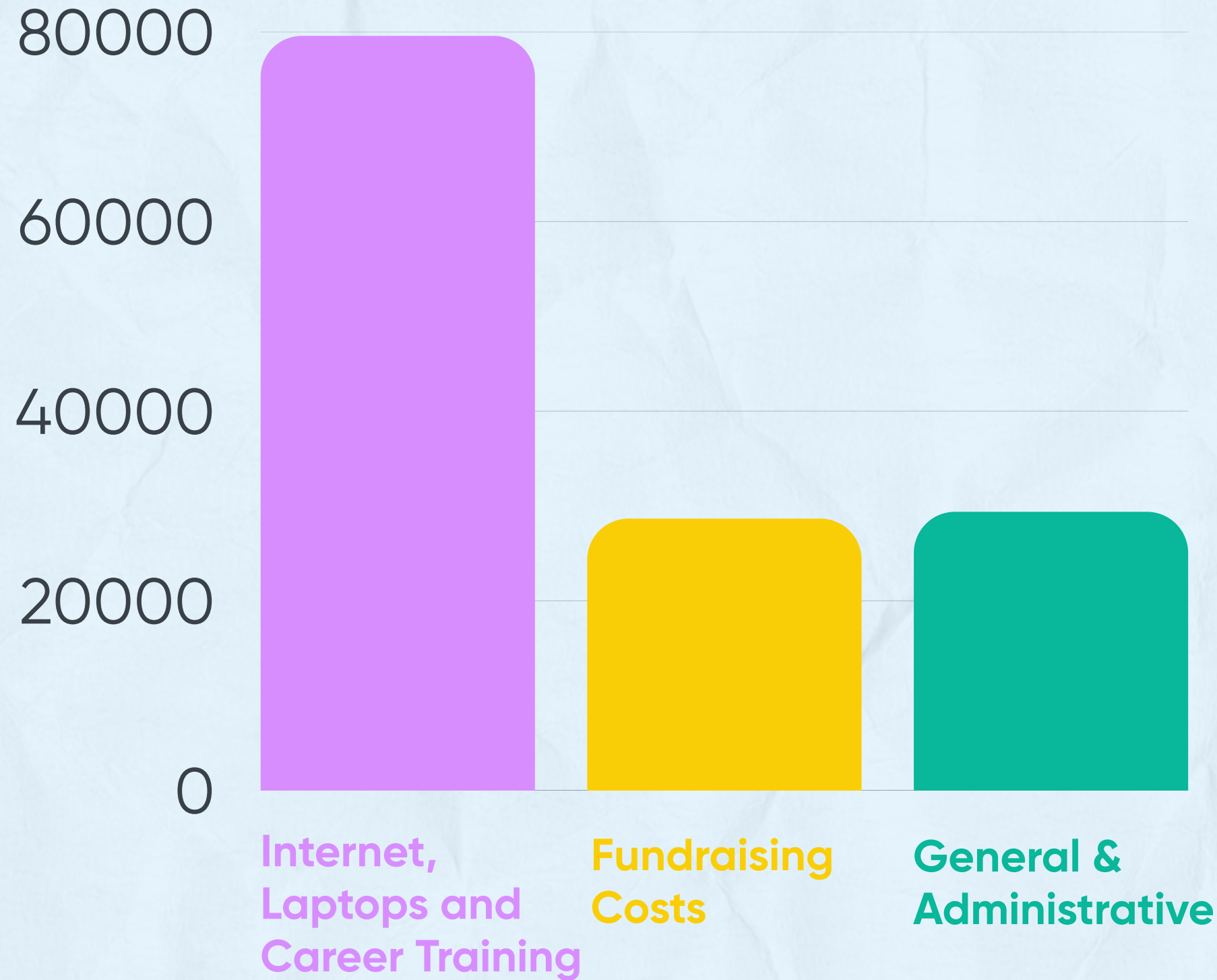
